Friday, June 5



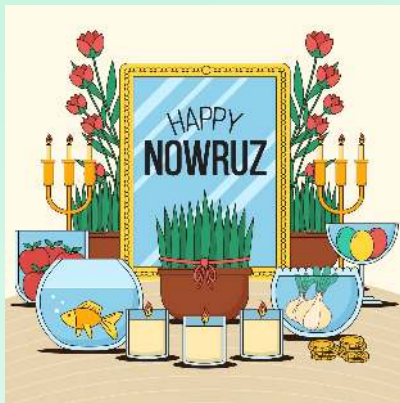
We will be using the **Munch-a-Lunch** ordering platform which families use to order PAC hot lunches. Please visit:
