



Thank you, **Mr. Fernando**, **Mr. Pal** and **Mr. Khan**, for all you do at Tait School.




Breakfast Club

Thank you for helping your child(ren) arrive at school by **8:40am** when the doors open so that they are settled and ready to learn when instruction begins at 8:45am.


If your child will be absent or late, please call the school's phone number at **604-668-6444** and **Press 1** to record your message. We are lucky to have only one phone number with two options.
