Please remind your child to check the Lost and Found for missing clothing or stop by the school to take a look. We will donate any extra clothing at the end of the school year.

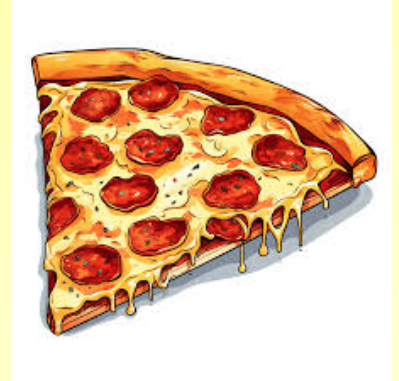


# Messages from our PAC

Dear Tait Parents and Guardians,

We are writing to let you know that next year's **Parent Advisory Council (PAC)** is in danger of dissolution as several of our current members are stepping down at the end of the school year. We are required to have at least a Chair, Secretary, and Treasurer to function.



**If we cannot form a committee, we will be unable to operate and provide things like hot lunch, field trip subsidies and movie night. We will also lose our funding from the BC Gaming Grant which provides \$20 dollars PER STUDENT to be put towards extracurricular programs such as school buses and student workshops.**

Please seriously consider volunteering for a PAC executive position. All parents and guardians are invited to apply for any position. Below are summaries of each position. If you have any questions or are interested in learning more about any of the PAC roles, please email [rjtaitpac@gmail.com](mailto:rjtaitpac@gmail.com).

**Chair** - to assume primary responsibility for coordinating the functioning of the R.J. Tait PAC, prepare Agendas and chair meetings. 2-year term

**Vice-Chair/Co-Chairperson** – to work with the chairperson, encourage parent participation and take on any special projects as needed.

**Secretary** – to record and post the minutes of the PAC meetings and answer all correspondence

**Treasurer** – to be responsible for all PAC funds and present a monthly financial statement at each PAC meeting

**RDPA Representative(s)** - to attend the Richmond District Parents' Association meetings, representing the R.J. Tait PAC and report RDPA news back to PAC

**Hot Lunch Coordinator** - work with local restaurants to source menus, costs and submit orders in order to offer hot lunch for students. Work through Munchalunch to set up ordering and use data to submit orders and plan/account for food inventory. Coordinate execution of hot lunch distribution including volunteer recruitment and scheduling.

Nominations can be made at our Annual General Meeting held **Monday, June 22**.

Even if you are not able to commit to an executive position, all parents and guardians of Tait students are PAC members and you can still play an important role by attending PAC meetings. This is where we decide what fundraisers to run and what events to hold. **We must have at least 5 members in attendance.** This year we had to cancel a meeting due to lack of attendance and we could not vote to allocate funds. The next PAC meeting is **Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup>** and we hope to see you there!
